Protection Concept Rifle Trophy 16-18 July 2021 at Schwadernau final version/09.07.2021

Basic information

Due to the 5th relaxation measures of the Federal Council/FOPH of 23 June 2021, the Rifle Trophy can be held under the following conditions.

In order to keep the spread of the Covid19 pandemic under control, the following basic rules must also be observed in shooting sports:

- Only symptom-free persons appear at the competition
(If a person from the delegation has symptoms, the competition management must be informed by the head of the delegation).
- Strict adherence to hygiene rules
- Keep 1.5m distance whenever possible

Arrival

- Every person at this event (athletes, coaches, delegation members, officials and staff as well as guests and spectators) must have a negative rapid test or PCR test with a smartphone (photo), which must not be more than 24 hours old. An entry control will be carried out.
- On the following days (Saturday and Sunday) no more tests have to be presented.

Shooting range 50m outdoor and 10m indoor

- All persons must wear masks at all times in the shooting ranges. Athletes may remove their masks at the firing point. If the athlete leaves the firing point or takes a seat (break) on the assigned chair, the mask must be put back on.
- In the 50m outdoor range, the obligation to wear a mask applies in particular because of the limited space (firing point and spectator area).

Indoors

- In indoor areas (offices, toilets, changing rooms, etc.), all persons must wear a mask when entering.

Information/disinfectants

- Official FOPH posters with rules of conduct at various locations refer to the "Covid19 Pandemic" rules of conduct.
- Stations with hand disinfectants are available at the range entrance.

At the shooting range

- There will be no disinfection of the firing point and utensils (control boxes, monitors; shooting tables, etc.) between relays.

Shooting preparation of the athletes / stay in the shooting range

- The dressing and preparation of the athletes for shooting shall take place outside of the shooting range or in the zone in front of the access to the firing point.

- Rotation (walking around) in the shooting range is not desired and must be kept to a minimum.

Stay of the sportsmen outside of their assignment

- This will take place outside the sports facilities or in the designated areas (recreation rooms or restaurant).
- Large gatherings and close congregations are to be avoided.

Restaurant

- In the restaurant, masks must be worn from the entrance to the seat. A mask does not have to be worn when sitting down. However, as soon as the person gets up, the mask must be put back on (e.g. for visiting the toilets, taking a smoke break, leaving the establishment, etc.).
- In the outdoor area of the restaurant (forecourt) there are no restrictions and there is no obligation to wear a mask.
- There are no restrictions on the number of persons at a table.
- Furthermore, the regulations of Gastro Swiss apply.

Personal responsibility

- This is explicitly pointed out

This protection concept is valid as a basic document for this event on the basis of the submission/regulations of the Swiss Shooting Sport Federation of 26.06.2021. Short-term adjustments (e.g. restrictions by the canton) remain reserved.
